

Coral Springs Basketball Club Tie Breaker

- 1) On a 2 teams tie: The winner of the head-to-head game(s) between the 2 teams affected will win the tie.
- 2) On a multiple teams tie: (Using the games played among the teams affected only), determine the order among them. *See example below*

After using the **tie breaker**, if you still have an unsolved tie, you will need to solve it as follow:

- 1) For any of the positions eligible for a trophy a tie-breaker-game needs to be played.
 - a. *Positions eligible for a trophy are:*
 - *Up to seven teams in a division: First and second place only.*
 - *8, 9 or 10 teams in a division: First, second and third place.*
 - *11 teams or more in a division: First, second, third and fourth place.*
 - b. *For all Trainee divisions and Intermediate Girls we also give participation trophies to all teams.*
- 2) For any other seeding position the Athletic Director will break the tie with a flip of a coin.

WE WILL NEVER USE POINT DIFFERENTIAL OR MARGIN OF VICTORY TO BREAK A TIE

Multiple Tie Breaker calculation example:

Division standing

Team #	Win	Lost
5	8	4
6	8	4
3	8	4
1	6	6
2	4	8
4	2	10

To solve the tie among teams (3, 5 and 6), we look for the games played by those 3 teams (only those games played against each of the tied teams).

Games scores:

Date	Home Team	Score	Away Team	Score
Oct/20	6	26	5	30
Oct/23	3	35	6	31
Oct/27	5	22	3	21
Nov/3	6	29	5	19
Nov/10	3	25	6	33

The tie-breaker (for those 3 teams only):

Team #	Win	Lost	Pct
5	2	1	.666
6	2	2	.500
3	1	2	.333

Therefore team 5 wins the tie breaker, team 6 is second and team 3 is third.
